3rd PhD-Student Workshop on Industrial and Public Economics (WIPE)

Paper Submission Procedure

Extended Abstracts of proposed papers (between 500 and 1,000 words) should be submitted electronically in PDF format by emailing to creip@urv.cat by 25 November 2014, along with the name, affiliation and contact details of the author(s). The deadline for notification of acceptance of abstracts is by 16 December 2014.

Full Papers (in the region of 8,000 words) of accepted abstracts should be submitted in Word or PDF format by **13 January 2015** to be included in the final workshop program. The front page of the document should include the title, authors, affiliations, contact details, and a short abstract.
