The Research Centre on Industrial and Public Economics (CREIP), created in 2010, is a centre located at the Economics Department of the Universitat Rovira i Virgili. Extended Abstracts of proposed papers (between 500 and 1,000 words) should be submitted electronically in PDF format by emailing to creip@urv.cat by 20th November 2012, along with the name, affiliation and contact details of the author(s). The deadline for notification of acceptance of abstracts is by 20th December 2012.

Full Papers (in the region of 8,000 words) of accepted abstracts should be submitted in Word or PDF format by **20**th **January 2013** to be included in the final workshop programme. The front page of the document should include the title, authors, affiliations, contact details, and a short abstract.
